GRADUATE NURSE PROGRAM

The Timboon and District Healthcare Service Graduate Nurse Program provides a supportive year for the graduate nurse to safely make the transition from a tertiary student into a confident and competent registered nurse.

The program aims to enable the graduate nurse to:

- Work independently and interdependently assuming accountability and responsibility for their own actions.
- Provide evidence-based nursing care to people of all ages and cultural groups
- Assess, plan, implement and evaluate nursing care in collaboration with individuals and the multidisciplinary health care team so as to achieve goals and health outcomes.
- Take a leadership role in the coordination of nursing and health care within and across different care contexts to facilitate optimal health outcomes.
- Contribute to quality health care through lifelong learning and professional development of oneself and others.





PROGRAM DURATION

The TDHS graduate nurse program runs for 52 weeks, from the 5th February 2024 to the 3 February 2025. Graduate nurses work 32 to 40 hours per week (EFT 0.8 to 1.0).

During this time you will be eligible for Supernumerary shifts, Education Sessions and Study days. You will also link in with other graduates located at South West Healthcare.
